- City Classroom: 13/F, Harvest Moon House, 337-339 Nathan Road, Jordan. Limited to 30 students at maximum.

- For Pastoral Training Programs students, their maximum earned credits through online teaching (including taking online mode in hybrid courses) is 10% of the credits required for graduation; other programs are 50% of the credits required for graduation. Students are required to choose the learning mode during registration (Online/Onsite).

! Remarks for Course Registration:

- CH2018: This course is accredited to CH1003 Church History I.
- DM2009: This course is accredited to DM1000 Introduction to Christian Theology.
- DM2010: This course is accredited to DM1001 Dogmatics I.
- CP2017/PT2052: 3 day-camps plus 3 group and 1 individual appointments. Limit to 12 students. Interview is required for admission.
- CP2036: This course is accredited to CP2001 Christian Counseling.
- CP2037/CT2007: This course is accredited to CP2015/CT2003 Christian Counseling Ethics or CP2016/RC2005 Counseling in Culture.
- CP2040: 4 lectures plus an individual supervision. Additional supervision fee will be charged. Pre-requisite course is "Cognitive Behavioral Therapy".
- CP2043/SW2046: This course is accredited to CP2000/SW2028 Life Development and Spiritual Growth.
- SW2027/PT2062: 7 lectures plus a 4-day retreat on 12-15/11, 2023. Limit to 25 students, first priority to SD/CS major, second priority to Pastoral Training Programs. No Auditor. Additional retreat and spiritual direction fees will be charged.
