- For Pastoral Training Programs students, their maximum earned credits through online teaching (including taking online mode in hybrid courses) is 10% of the credits required for graduation; other programs are 50% of the credits required for graduation. ! Remarks for Course Registration:

- OT2033, CH2002, DM2010: With tutor support to the Chinese students.
- HT2002/CT2002: This course is accredited to CT3002 Ethics in Christian Ministry in DMIN program.
- CP2039: Pre-requisite course is "Personal Growth". Limit to 18 students, first priority to Counseling major programs. Interview is required for admission. Additional camp fees will be charged.
- CP2041: Pre-requisite course is "Essential Counseling Skills". Limit to 12 students. Additional supervision fees will be charged.
- CP3017: Pre-requisite course is "Essential Counseling Skills".
- DK2001/MC2015: This course is accredited to MC4001 Missiology Seminar in DMIN program.
- SW2027/PT2062: Limit to 15 students, first priority to SD/CS major and then Pastoral Training Programs. Students taking credits also come first. Additional retreat and spiritual direction fees will be charged.
- LL1004: First class on 12/1 (Fri), and the following schedule will be arranged separately.
