Remarks:

- Courses marked with "*" are taught in English, "m" are taught in Putonghua, and other courses are taught in Cantonese.
- Courses with insufficient enrollment (four or less) may be cancelled. Translation services are only provided for classes with at least five students in need.
- Course without special remarks, the venue is TFS Campus (50 To Fung Shan Road, Shatin).
- City Classroom (Jordan): 13/F, Harvest Moon House, 337-339 Nathan Road, Jordan. Limited to 30 students at maximum.
- City Classroom (Wong Tai Sin): 2/F, Shek On Building, 8 Chun Yan Street, Wong Tai Sin. Limited to 30 students at maximum.
- For Pastoral Training Programs students, their maximum earned credits through online teaching (including taking online mode in hybrid courses) is 10% of the credits required for graduation; other programs are 50% of the credits required for graduation. Students are required to choose the learning mode during registration (Online/Onsite).

! Remarks for Course Registration:

- CE1000, DM2010: With tutor support to the Chinese students.
- CP2037/CT2007: This course is unsuitable for students majoring in professional counseling practicum.
- CP2040: Pre-requisite course is CP2034 Cognitive Behavioral Therapy. Limit to 12 students. Additional supervision fees will be charged. Only for students in the master program or above.
- CP3016: Only for students in master program or above.
- CP3019: Pre-requisite course is CP2012 Theories and Practice in Group Counseling. Only for students in the master program or above. Additional supervision fees will be charged.
- NT3027/OT3018: No class on 24/2, a supplementary session is scheduled for 28/4.
- OT2026/NT2029/JS2010: This course required at least 10 students for enrollment. The course will be cancelled if there are insufficient students.
- SW2029: This course is taught in bilingual English and Cantonese. Additional camp fees will be charged.
